Minimal Setup, Maximum Impact: Johnny's 3 Presentation Must-Haves

1. Projector

Johnny's presentation is uniquely tailored with pre-loaded video clips, custom fonts and proprietary visuals. To ensure the best quality, Johnny presents directly from his MacBook. An HDMI connection is ideal for seamless integration.

2. Sound (Audio)

Johnny's presentation includes engaging video clips that require clear audio for the audience. Audio is typically connected through the headphone port of his MacBook to deliver optimal sound quality.

3. Microphone

Johnny is an energetic speaker who moves around the stage to engage the audience. A headset or lapel microphone is preferred for freedom of movement. If unavailable, a wireless handheld microphone works as a backup.

Things to Keep in Mind:

- Johnny does **not** require an internet connection to run his presentation.
- If using a "switch," ensure the High Definition Copyright Protection (HDCP) is set to **OFF**.
- Johnny travels with his own slide advancer (clicker) but is happy to use yours if it offers better range.
- Johnny prefers his MacBook to be on stage or next to the stage. If that's not possible, he must be able to **see his MacBook screen clearly from the stage**.
 - If the AV table is at the back of the room, please provide a way to prop up Johnny's MacBook (e.g., stack of books, small stand, or box).
 - His slides are color-coded, so he doesn't need to read text on the screen—just a clear view to glance at the next slide's color coding.
